APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Financial:

Resolution Confirming SEQR Determination CK Properties

The next step in the process is for the accept the determination by the City of Cohoes Planning Board to act as Lead agency for the Environmental Review of the CK2 Properties, LLC. Ms. Stark made a motion to approve the Resolution. Mr. Dion seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commercial/Retail Finding Resolution CK Properties Project

Ms. Zeigler stated that based on the plans the project will create 2 part-time jobs and 25 temporary construction jobs. Mr. Jacobson made a motion to approve the Resolution. Mr. Dion seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approving Resolution CK Properties Project

Ms. Zeigler stated that the board needs to approve the resolution authorizing the execution of documents in connection with a Lease/Leaseback transaction for the CK2 Properties, LLC. Mr. Dion made a motion to approve the Resolution. Dr. Spring seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Resolution Confirming SEQR Determination 100 N5 Project

Ms. Zeigler stated that this project will not provide more than \$100,000 of Financial Assistance to the Company and a public hearing is not required with respect to the project. Ms. Zeigler

further stated that this Resolution will appoint the City of Cohoes Planning Board to act as Lead Agency for the Environmental Review of the Project. Mr. Jacobson made a motion to approve the Resolution. Ms. Stark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commerical/Retail Findings Resolution 100 N5, LLC Project

Ms. Zeigler stated that the board needs to approve a Resolution determining that the proposed project is a commercial project and making certain findings required under the General Municipal Law. Ms. Zeigler further stated that the project is expected to create 2 part-time permanent jobs. Mr. Jacobson made a motion to approve the Resolution. Ms. Stark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approving Resolution 100 N5, LLC Project

Ms. Zeigler stated the board needs to approve the resolution authorizing the execution of documents in connection with a Lease/Leaseback transaction for the project for 100 N5, LLC. Mr. Dion made a motion to approve the project. Ms. Stark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Line of Credit

Mr. Signoracci stated that the Pioneer Bank Line of Closing will be at 2:00 today and once the closing takes place we will be able to start acquiring parcels for development.

Mr. Dion wanted to let the board know that he was a business function recently and there were several business people discussing all of the good things going on in Cohoes. Mr. Morse stated that we are all excited about the projects that are in the pipeline. He further stated that the Business Review recently did a nice article on Cohoes.

Ms. Zeigler stated that she received a call from the attorneys for Admiral's Walk regarding a refinance on the project and they need the IDA to execute some forms. Mr. Durocher stated that he did not believe that there was an outstanding PILOT on that project but he would pull the paperwork and get back to Ms. Zeigler.
